 - Definition and management of all quality related processes and procedures including budgetary control issues
 - Definition and measurement of related KPI's
 - Lead team of test engineers but also be hands-on
 - Working with purchasing staff to establish quality requirements from external suppliers
 - Assessing the product specifications of the company and its suppliers, and comparing with (customer) requirements

 - Definition and measurement of related KPI's (collating and analysing performance data and charts against defined parameters)
